

## **Bob Smith**

Bob is head of the Department of Sustainable Biomaterials and Associate Dean for Extension in the College of Natural Resources and Environment at Virginia Tech. In his current role, he leads 17 faculty in one of the leading departments in sustainable biomaterial science in North America. Bob holds a Ph.D. from Virginia Tech in Forest Products Marketing, a MBA from the University of Wisconsin at Oshkosh, and a B.S. in Wood and Fiber Utilization from Michigan Tech. Prior to coming to Virginia Tech, Bob worked for fourteen years in the forest products industry as a production manager and sales representative in the Midwest. Bob has taught undergraduate and graduate courses in the areas of wood science, business management, and forest products marketing. Bob has served on the Forest Research Advisory Council (FRAC) of the USDA. This council recommends the forestry research agenda for the USDA. Bob is the current president of the Society of Wood Science and Technology (SWST), and has served on the boards of the Virginia Forestry Association, the Virginia Forest Products Association, and the Softwood Export Council.
